

Declaration by Publication Licensing Applicant

The Applicant (a company or any person or business entity engaged in publication or related business) hereby applies to the **National Palace Museum** (the “NPM”) for publication licensing of _____ **(Title of Publication)**, and hereby makes the following declarations:

1	The Applicant’s registered business scope does not comply with the requirements of the Company Act or the Business Registration Act, and therefore the Applicant is unable, upon being granted the license, to act as a contracting party and lawfully perform the contract.		
2	The Applicant or its chairman (the authorized representative) has any relationship with the head of the licensing authority involving personal interest as defined by applicable laws, including the person himself/herself, spouse, relatives by blood or marriage within the third degree of kinship, or family members living together and sharing property.

In the event of any violation of such regulations, the NPM may terminate or rescind the contract.		
4	The Applicant, any co-licensed person/entity, or subcontractor is a party prohibited by applicable laws from participating in licensing or acting as a contracting or subcontracting party. [Prior to making application, the Applicant shall verify via the Public Construction Commission website (web.pcc.gov.tw) whether it (including its head office and branches), co-licensed person/entity, or any of its subcontractors is listed as an entity barred from transactions under Article 103, Paragraph 1 of the Government Procurement Act.]		
5	With respect to this licensing application, the Applicant constitutes a “public official” or a “related person” as defined under Articles 2 and 3 of the Act on Recusal of Public Servants Due to Conflicts of Interest, and the transaction may violate Article 9 thereof, which prohibits such persons from engaging in transactions (including sale, lease, or contracting) with		

	the agency they serve or supervise. [Pursuant to Article 15 of the same Act, a fine ranging from one (1) to three (3) times the transaction amount may be imposed.]

Any such applicant shall not be accepted as a contracting party. If any declaration herein is inaccurate or untrue, the Applicant shall likewise be deemed ineligible for licensing.</p> <p>2.
